## Scholarship awards break record

The largest amount of scholarship funds – \$94,000 – ever given by the ARA Foundation and its affiliate programs has been awarded to 40 students for the 2018-2019 school year.

The top applicant was **Dylan Kohn** with Miller's Rentals & Sales in Edison, N.J. He received the Leonard Hawk Founders Scholarship worth \$5,000, the ARA Insurance Scholarship worth \$3,500 and a Region Two Ron Marshall Scholarship worth \$750 for a total of \$9,250.

## Technical Training Grants help companies fulfill their training goals

When **Derek Potter**, human resources director at Vandalia Rental in Vandalia, Ohio, learned about the Technical Training Grants offered by the ARA Foundation, he did not hesitate to apply.

"When we saw that this was available, we wanted to take advantage of partnering with the ARA Foundation to bring additional training to the team. Having a partner who is willing to help bear some of the cost burden allows you more opportunity to get your team trained, and it's easier to think of the training as an investment to advance your team and your company and help you grow. Our employee has now successfully completed the Class A CDL [commercial driver's license] training," Potter says.

Likewise, **Allan Haynsworth**, president of Atlantic Lift Systems in Norfolk, Va., applied for and received a grant to offer Tier 4 engine training. "The reason we train is because we want to offer our clients superior service. From a training aspect, this grant gives our team members more knowledge and makes them more valuable across the board," he says.

**Donna Doran**, manager at Dwight Crane in Ajax, Ontario, Canada, also successfully applied for and received a grant for one of her employees to receive welding supervisor certification.

"We are a small operation, but we are very diversified with many different trades, from welders to mechanics. We need to keep everyone up on everything they need to know. Plus, we need to keep everyone trained on the forklifts and cranes. It becomes more and more financially challenging to keep everybody trained. When I saw that the grant was offered, I wanted to see whether we could get some help," she says.

Offsetting the cost of the training is a significant benefit – but

not the only advantage. It appears to be a boon to overall employee retention and recruitment of new employees, these rental operators say.

It "absolutely" helps retain and recruit employees, Potter says. "Training makes us better — helps us go from good to great. It makes us more competitive. Additionally, it helps

increase awareness, gets our team to better understand what it takes to be successful and serves as an investment into our team. It shows that we do care, that we want to help employees grow and provide additional opportunities to grow with the business and the industry. One of the biggest complaints I hear from prospective employees is that they don't have advancement opportunities at their work. That often is the way I can get people to our business."

## Young Professionals Committee sets goals to strengthen reach and benefits for all

- Hold more structured professional events. This began at the YPN Reception during The ARA Show™ in New Orleans. In addition, more educational sessions specifically geared for YPNs will be incorporated at the Show in 2019 and at other venues.
- Integrate more YPN opportunities with state association activities. This will allow more young professionals to benefit from what the YPN offers.

"There is so much this networking

organization has to offer to young professionals. We wanted to show the members that this is an active organization, that there are others in the industry experiencing the same obstacles and successes, and that we are listening to the members and owners and working to create the structural education that people have requested," says **Julie Creedon-Linton, CERP**, vice president of Creedon & Co. in Worcester, Mass., and chair of the Young Professionals Committee.

"Young professionals are hungry for education and for ways to grow personally and within the industry," Creedon-Linton says. "They want to meet new people who can understand the circumstances they live and breathe every day. They want strong bonds with others in the industry to bounce ideas off of outside of Young Professional Network events and conferences."

With the goals set by the Young Professionals Committee, those opportunities to network and learn will only strengthen, benefiting everyone in the industry.

- Employee Disaster Relief Grants: These grants, ranging from \$500 to \$2,000, are provided to employees who have been affected by a natural disaster. Business owners must apply for these grants on behalf of their employees. To do so, go to ARAfoundation.com/go/EmployeeRecovery.
- **Disaster Matching Funds Program:** This program offers matching funds for donations made by ARA state, local or provincial assciations to charitable organizations that
